Skills Required:

- ability to mentor our participants while modeling appropriate behavior and communication
- ability to connect, engage and relate to individuals with special needs
- ability to encourage appropriate work habits and social skills
- work as a team player and be willing to take direction from Team Leads
- must be at least 18 years of age
- high school diploma or on track to receive one, preferred
