Why Piedmont Midtown:

Piedmont Columbus Regional’s Midtown Campus is the region’s largest acute care hospital and the primary referral center for west Georgia and east Alabama. The 583-bed hospital serves as the flagship facility for the region and provides a comprehensive array of services designed to meet the needs of a large and diverse population.

Midtown is home to both the John B. Amos Cancer Center as well as the Bill and Olivia Amos Children’s Hospital which is the region’s only children’s hospital and a Children’s Miracle Network affiliate. Midtown is comprised of both onsite inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation services for all three disciplines. Specialty services lines include pediatrics, NICU, critical care (adult and pediatric), oncology, cardiopulmonary, ortho-trauma, and neurology. Piedmont Midtown is a Primary Plus Stroke Center with thrombectomy capabilities and is the region’s largest care provider of stroke patients.

Why Piedmont Northside:

Piedmont Columbus Regional’s Northside Campus is a licensed 100-bed general acute care hospital specializing in orthopedic, spine, bariatrics, and surgical services. The campus operates a 20-bed Emergency Department. Our Northside campus also comprises of a satellite outpatient therapy clinic that is in a prime location for rehab program development in North Columbus.

Complementing these amenities is a revitalized downtown that blends historic character with modern development. The area offers a growing collection of chef-driven, locally owned restaurants, upscale dining options, and social venues, supporting an active evening and weekend economy.
